My Mulch

Dear Steve,

I received your letter regarding the mulch that I had my private landscapers apply in my gardens. Just to clarify it is mulch not hay. I'm not sure who did the inspection it but it is clearly mulch.

The designated 50 bags of dark mulch that Artistree installed barely covered 1" on the front and half way down the right side of my property. A 1" cover is fine for looking good but is not enough to keep the weeds at bay and nurture the soil before planting. That was the purpose for adding additional mulch.

My gardeners chose this wood mulch which is comprised of shredded pine because it was most suited for giving my plantings the best, most nutritious start. I know from previous ownership in UPCC that we have a choice between dark mulch and pine mulch. I did not ask my landscapers what color the pine mulch was that they were ordering because I knew pine was already approved.

I have owned 4 homes in UPCC in the past 15+ years. Unless the mulch requirements have changed I think I was within the guidelines.
